The Endowment Committee will be meeting soon and would like to have any requests for funds submitted to the church office or Steve Sanderson by the end of June

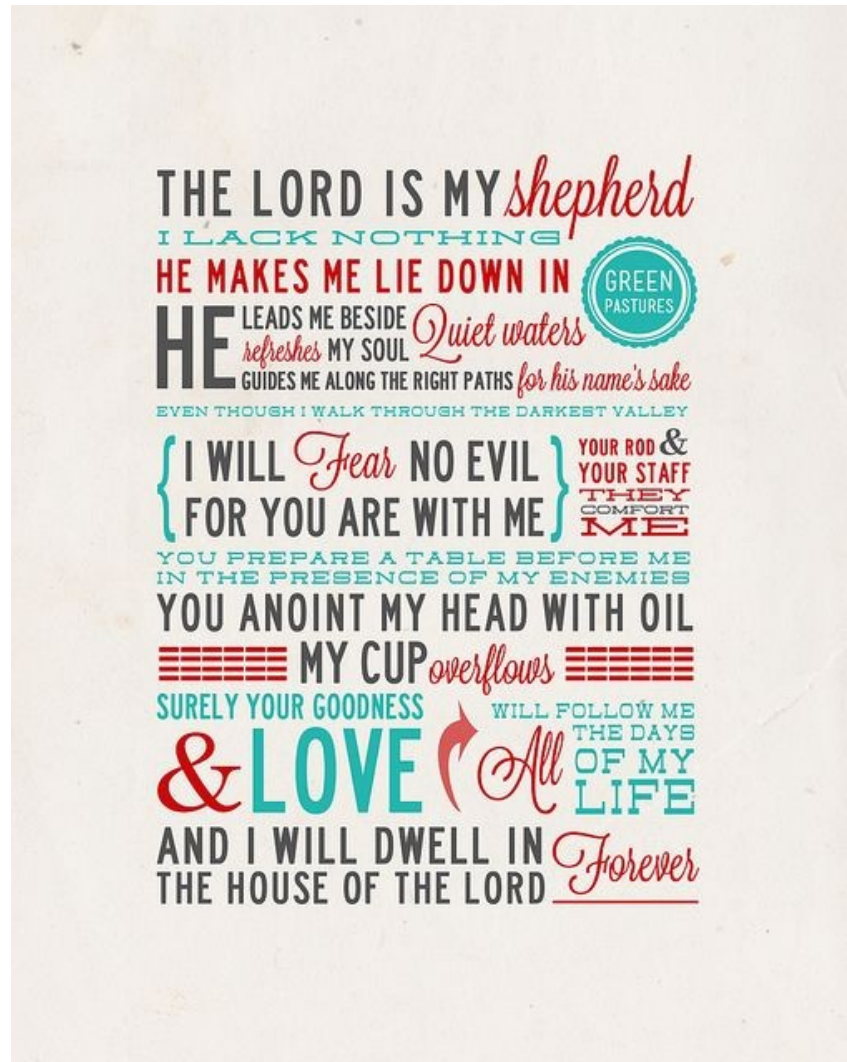
