The Endowment committee has met, reviewed 2018 operations and are now accepting requests for funds for 2019.

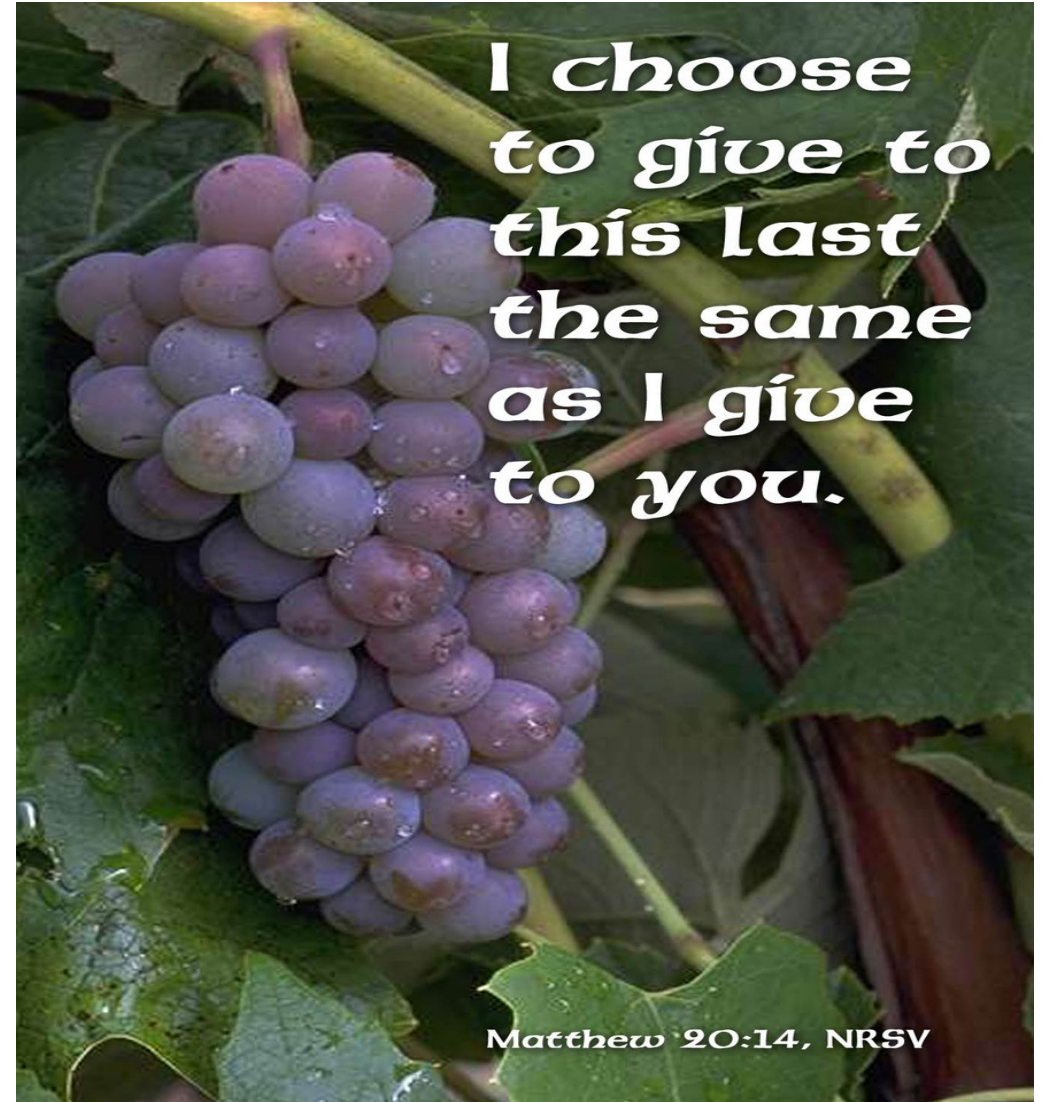
